De Europese Ruimte Conferentie heeft op 24 juli 1970 tijdens haar van 22-24 juli 1970 te Brussel gehouden zitting de volgende Resolutie aangenomen:

Resolution [No. 3]

Cooperation in the post-Apollo programme

The Conference

Having noted with great interest the possibility of European participation in the post-Apollo programme, as suggested by the Administrator of NASA to the Committee of Senior Officials,

Having noted furthermore the observations made by the Committee of Senior Officials,

Recognising that participation in this programme, if decided, could become within the next decade a most important task of the new European space organisation,

Notes with satisfaction the steps already undertaken for ensuring close contracts between the existing European Organisations and NASA with a view to following the preparatory work for this future programme and preparing suggestions for a possible European participation,

Decides that these contracts and exploratory work must be pursued and, whenever needed, strengthened and intensified under the authority and the guidance of the ESC,

Asks the joint ESRO and ELDO Technical Working Group created for that purpose to submit by end 1970 a first report on possible fields and forms of cooperation to the President of the European Space Conference, for subsequent submission to the Governments of the ESC Member States; this report shall also contain a plan for the organisation in Europe of such cooperation, on the national and international level,

Entrusts to the President of the ESC supported by representatives of France and the United Kingdom the task of exploring on behalf of the ESC, with the Government of the United States of America, the political, financial and other conditions for possible European participation, and requests him to report on these to the Governments of the Member States not later than 1 December 1970,

Decides that all possibilities for European participation should be studied, where necessary in close collaboration with NASA,

Endorses the action already taken by the ELDO Council in deciding to undertake industrial studies of a tug system, as one possible area of European participation, and notes with satisfaction the decision of the Governments of Australia, Spain and Switzerland to participate in this study,

Agrees to make funds available for such studies in the period to June 1971 up to a maximum of 2.5 MMU provided that the objectives of the studies shall be approved by the Committee of Alternates on behalf of the ESC,

Invites all Member States of the ESC to participate in such studies, the financing of which shall be shared by the participating states according to the rules applicable in ELDO and ESRO,

Invites the Member States to instruct their national Delegations to the Councils of ESRO and ELDO to take the necessary decisions to implement this Resolution,

Decides that in the light of the outcome of the negotiations, the participating States shall together reconsider the conditions for the carrying-out of the European programmes, in particular where launchers are concerned.

Van het op 29 maart 1962 te Londen gesloten Verdrag tot oprichting van een Europese Organisatie voor de ontwikkeling en de vervaardiging van dragers van ruimtevoertuigen (Engelse afkorting: ELDO; Franse afkorting: CECLES) zie ook, laatstelijk, *Trb.* 1971, 196.

Op 15 februari 1973 is te Neuilly-sur-Seine tot stand gekomen de Overeenkomst tussen bepaalde Lid-Staten van de Europese Organisatie voor Ruimteonderzoek en de Europese Organisatie voor Ruimteonderzoek betreffende de uitvoering van het ruimtelaboratoriumprogramma (met bijlagen), in de preambule van welke Overeenkomst wordt verwezen naar de hierboven afgedrukte Resolutie (tekst van de Overeenkomst in *Trb.* 1974, 105).
