Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that the Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency plans to hold a co-ordination meeting of research workers participating in the "Co-ordinated Research Programme on Comparative Methods for the Study of Trace Elements in Human Nutrition" in November 1981. The objective of the meeting is to discuss and evaluate the results obtained so far and the future plans of work of the investigators for better co-ordination of their efforts.

Subsequent to discussions between the Secretariat and the Permanent Mission, it was suggested that the meeting be held at the Interuniversitair Reactor Instituut in Delft during the period 25 to 27 November 1981. The duration of the meeting would be three (3) days and approximately

eleven (11) scientists are expected to attend (from Chile, the Federal Republic of Germany, India, Iran, Italy, the Netherlands, the Philippines, Turkey, the United States of America and Yugoslavia).

In the event that the Government of the Netherlands is willing to host this meeting, may I request confirmation that the Government would agree to make the following arrangements which are common to all meetings held away from the Headquarters of the Agency:

1. With regard to the meeting the Agreement on the Privileges and Immunities of the International Atomic Energy Agency of 1 July 1959 shall apply.

2. The Government of the Netherlands shall grant free of charge visas and necessary facilities to the participants of the meeting.

3. The Government of the Netherlands shall exercise all reasonable care to ensure security on the premises in which the meeting takes place and to ensure the safety of the officials and participants concerned while on such premises. The Government shall take whatever steps may be reasonably required in the circumstances to ensure such security and safety, including such supervision of the premises as may be warranted.

I would appreciate receiving in writing your Government's agreement to the above enumerated points as soon as possible.
