INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY

20 november 1981

Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that the Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency is planning to hold an Advisory Group Meeting on Nuclear Structure and Decay Data on 11-14 May 1982. 27 persons from 13 countries are expected to attend the meeting.

The existence of research programmes at the Fysisch Laboratorium of the Rijksuniversiteit Utrecht which are of direct pertinence to this meeting makes it very desirable to hold this meeting in the vicinity of this location. In the course of preliminary correspondence, Dr. C. van der Leun of the Fysisch Laboratorium has expressed interest to help to organize this meeting, and has extended to us an informal invitation.

I have the honour to enquire whether your Government would wish to host this meeting at the proposed location, in which event your Government would be expected to make the following arrangements which are common to all meetings held away from the Headquarters of the Agency:

1. With regard to the meeting the Agreement on the Privileges and Immunities of the International Atomic Energy Agency of 1 July 1959 shall apply.

2. The Government of the Netherlands shall grant free of charge visas and necessary facilities to the participants of the meeting. Annex A contains the list of Member States invited to participate.

3. The Government of the Netherlands shall exercise all reasonable care to ensure security on the premises in which the meeting takes place and to ensure the safety of the officials and participants concerned while on such premises. The Government shall take whatever steps may be reasonably required in the circumstances to ensure such security and safety, including such supervision of the premises as may be warranted.

Should your Government wish to host the meeting in question, I should appreciate receiving in writing your Government's agreement on the above enumerated points.

Accept, Sir, the assurances of my highest consideration.
