Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that the International Atomic Energy Agency is planning to hold a Specialists' Meeting on Theoretical and Experimental Work on LMFBR Steam Generator Safety with Particular Reference to Leak Development and Detection in November 1983. This meeting is within the programme of activities of the IAEA International Working Group on Fast Reactors (IWGFR).

The purpose of the meeting is to provide a forum for discussions and exchanging views on leak development in LMFBR steam generators, definition of design basis accidents in the steam generator, experimental and theoretical studies on leak simulation. Topics also of interest are operation and maintenance aspects, leak detection, and influence of leak development studies on a design of steam generator.

The DeBeNe representatives have been participating actively in this group for a number of years. At its 15th Annual Meeting in 1982 the IWGFR recommended that this meeting be convened in the Netherlands. After consultations with the DeBeNe representatives it was suggested that the specialists' meeting could be held on 9-11 November 1983 in the Hague. About 25-30 experts from IAEA Member States are expected to attend the meeting. The working language of the meeting will be English.

I have the honour to enquire if your Government would be prepared to host the meeting in question, in which event your Government would be expected to make the following arrangements.

1. With regard to the meeting the Agreement on the Privileges and Immunities of the IAEA of 1st July 1959 shall apply.

2. The Government of the Netherlands shall grant free of charge visas and necessary facilities to the participants of the meeting. Annex A contains a list of Member States to be invited to participate.

3. The Government of the Netherlands shall exercise all reasonable care to ensure security on the premises in which the meeting takes place and to ensure the safety of the officials of the Agency and participants concerned while on such premises. The Government shall take whatever steps may be reasonably required in the circumstances to ensure such security and such safety, including such supervision of the premises as may be warranted.

Should your Government wish to host the meeting in question, I should appreciate receiving in writing your Government's agreement on the above enumerated points at your earliest convenience so as to enable the Secretariat to proceed with timely arrangements.

Mr. V. F. Efimenko, the Scientific Secretary of the IWGFR, will provide liaison between the Agency and the organizers of the meeting.
