Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that the International Atomic Energy Agency is planning to hold the last research co-ordination meeting of investigators participating in the Co-ordinated Research Programme on Nuclear Methods for Health-related Monitoring of Trace element Pollutants.

The purpose of the meeting is to review and evaluate the results obtained during the three-year duration of the programme, and to discuss the need for a further programme to replace the completed one. The duration of the meeting would be five days, preferably from 16 to 20 May 1983, and approximately twelve research workers are expected

to attend from Austria, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, Egypt, Federal Republic of Germany, German Democratic Republic, Greece, Iran, the Netherlands, Sudan and Zaire.

I have the honour to enquire whether your Government would wish to host the meeting in question, in which event your Government would be expected to make the following arrangements, which are common to similar meetings held away from the Headquarters of the Agency.

1. With regard to the meeting the Agreement on the Privileges and Immunities of the International Atomic Energy Agency of 1 July 1959 shall apply.

2. The Government of the Netherlands shall grant free of charge visas and necessary facilities to the participants of the meeting. A list of anticipated participants is herewith attached.

3. The Government of the Netherlands shall exercise all reasonable care to ensure security on the premises in which the meeting takes place and to ensure the safety of the officials and participants concerned while on such premises. The Government shall take whatever steps may be reasonably required in the circumstances to ensure such security and safety, including such supervision of the premises as may be warranted.

Mr. S. B. M'Baku of the Division of Life Sciences, who is the Project Officer for the programme and the Scientific Secretary for the meeting, has discussed this matter informally with Mr. H. A. Das from Netherlands, Energy Research Foundation ECN, Petten, the Netherlands, who has been associated with this IAEA Co-ordinated Research Programme.

Should your Government wish to host the meeting in question I should appreciate receiving in writing your Government's agreement on the above enumerated points at your early convenience so as to enable the Secretariat to proceed with timely arrangements.
