Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that the Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency is planning to hold an Advisory Group Meeting on Nuclear and Atomic Data for Medical Radiotherapy and Related Radiobiology, during the week of 16–20 September 1985.

The purpose of the meeting is to review the current status of nuclear and atomic data requirements for radiotherapy and radiobiology and to identify and specify the data needs in this field. This meeting is based on the recommendation made by the International Nuclear Data Committee (INDC) at its last meeting in October 1984. Following initial correspondence with Mr. J. J. Broerse, Radiobiological Institute TNO, Rijswijk, (Director: Prof. D. W. van Bekkum), it has been suggested that the proposed meeting could be held at the Radiobiological Institute TNO during the above mentioned period. It is expected that about 25 scientists

from several Member States will participate in the meeting. The Information Sheet and Preliminary Programme are attached.¹⁾

I have the honour to enquire whether the Government would wish to host the meeting in question, in which event the Government would be expected to make the following arrangements:

1. With regard to the meeting the Agreement on the Privileges and Immunities of the IAEA of 1st July 1959 shall apply.

2. The Government of the Netherlands shall grant free of charge visas and necessary facilities to the participants of the meeting.

3. The Government of the Netherlands shall exercise all reasonable care to ensure security on the premises in which the meeting takes place and to ensure the safety of the officials of the Agency and participants concerned while on such premises. The Government shall take whatever steps may be reasonably required in the circumstances to ensure such security and such safety, including such supervision of the premises as may be warranted.

4. The Government shall make available to the Agency, without charge, and for the entire duration of the meeting, premises and facilities adequate and appropriate for the meeting.

Mr. K. Okamoto of the Nuclear Data Section, will be the Scientific Secretary of the Advisory Group Meeting. Mr. J. J. Broerse, who is a member of the organizing committee, will be in charge of the arrangements in Rijswijk.

Should your Government wish to host the meeting in question, I would appreciate receiving in writing your Government's agreement on the above enumerated points as soon as possible so as to enable the Secretariat to proceed with timely arrangements.

Accept, Sir, the assurances of my highest consideration.
