Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that the Secretariat of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations and the International Atomic Energy Agency, through their Joint FAO/IAEA Division of Nuclear Techniques in Food and Agriculture, are planning to hold the first Research Co-ordination Meeting (RCM) on Food Irradiation for

the Middle East and European Countries, in Wageningen, the Netherlands from 17 to 21 April 1989.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the details of work to be carried out under this Co-ordinated Research Programme in the next five years and to recommend a co-ordinated plan of action. Fifteen scientists from Bulgaria, Finland, France, German Democratic Republic, Hungary, Islamic Republic of Iran, Iraq, The Netherlands, Poland, United Kingdom, and Yugoslavia would be expected to attend. The names and addresses of the expected participants are attached.

Dr. P. Loaharanu, Food Preservation Section, Joint FAO/IAEA Division, has had unofficial contact with Dr. G. S. Roosje, Director, State Institute for Quality Control and Agricultural Products (RIKILT), who expressed his willingness to assist the sponsoring Organizations in holding the meeting in his institute.

I have the honour to enquire whether the Government would wish to host the meeting in question, in which event the Government would be expected to make the following arrangements:

1. With regard to the meeting the Agreements on the Privileges and Immunities of the IAEA of 1st July 1959 shall apply.
2. The Government of the Netherlands shall grant free of charge visas and necessary facilities to the participants of the meeting.
3. The Government of the Netherlands shall exercise all reasonable care to ensure security on the premises in which the meeting takes place and to ensure safety of the officials of the sponsoring Organizations and participants concerned while on such premises. The Government shall take whatever steps may be reasonably required in the circumstances to ensure such security and such safety, including such supervision of the premises as may be warranted.
4. The Government shall make available to the sponsoring Organizations, without charge, and for the entire duration of the meeting, premises and facilities adequate and appropriate for the meeting.

The sponsoring Organizations shall inform the Government promptly of all persons officially designated to attend the meeting. The sponsoring Organizations shall also inform such persons to apply for visas, if necessary, in good time before the opening date of the meeting, and the Government is expected to issue such visas promptly so as to allow participants to attend the meeting.

Should your Government wish to host the meeting in question, I would appreciate receiving in writing your Government's agreement on the above enumerated points as soon as possible so as to enable the Secretariat to proceed with timely arrangements.
