The Ministry of Foreign Affairs presents its compliments to the Royal Netherlands Embassy and has the honour to inform that from 15 January to 8 February, 1991 the Meeting of Experts of the CSCE countries on the Peaceful Settlement of Disputes will take place in Valletta.

In order to secure legal status of the PSD Meeting, the Government of Malta intends to apply the immunities and privileges of the United Nations Convention of 1969 on Special Missions, regardless of the fact that Malta has not signed the UN Convention of 1969. This legal status will apply to all participants for the duration of the Meeting and to the Executive Secretariat and its staff regardless of their nationality as long as the PSD Secretariat is in function in Valletta.

Provided that the above proposals are acceptable, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs has the honour to suggest that this Note and the positive answer to it are to be regarded as an agreement between the two Governments. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs will appreciate an

early reply in order that the agreement may come into force as from 10 January, 1991.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Royal Netherlands Embassy the assurances of its highest consideration.

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 8 January 1991 which reads as follows:

I have the honour to inform you that regardless of the fact that the Kingdom of the Netherlands is not a party to the UN-Convention on special missions, 8 december 1969, it is acceptable to the Netherlands Government that the privileges and immunities of this Convention will apply to all participants for the duration of the meeting.

My government considers your letter and my reply as an agreement between the Kingdom of the Netherlands and Malta, which shall enter into force on the date of this reply and shall remain in force for the duration of the meeting.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to you Mr Minister the assurances of my highest esteem.
